As the Coronavirus takes a growing toll on people's pocketbooks and mental health, there are reports that the government will possibly soon be sending money by check or direct deposit to each of us. The details are still being worked out, but there are a few very important things to know and be aware of no matter the final outcome.

- ✓ The government will not ask you to pay anything up front to get this money. No fees, no charges, nothing.
- ✓ The government will never ask you for your login credentials to your online banking. NEVER.
- ✓ The government will not call and ask you for your social security number, birthdate, bank account number or credit card number. Anyone who does is a scammer.
- ✓ These reports of checks are not a reality yet. Anyone who tells you they can get the money to you faster for a fee is a scammer.
- ✓ The government or any other reputable business will never ask you to buy gift cards and ask for the gift card number over the phone.
- ✓ Always verify the authenticity of someone receiving a wire from you.
